AN ACT ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2014*) The sum of six hundred fifty
2 thousand dollars is appropriated to the Department of Public Health,
3 from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, for the
4 purpose of establishing and operating school-based health centers at
5 Pleasant Valley Elementary School and Mary Morrisson Elementary
6 School, both of which are located in the town of Groton, and
7 Connecticut River Academy, the Early Childhood Magnet School and
8 the Summer Bridge Academy at Goodwin College, all of which are
9 located in the town of East Hartford.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
