"AN ACT CONCERNING AGING."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 17b-420a of the 2014 supplement to the general
4 statutes is amended by adding subsection (f) as follows (*Effective July 1,*
5 *2014*):

6 (NEW) (f) Not later than January 1, 2015, the Commission on Aging,
7 as part of the livable community initiative established pursuant to this
8 section, shall recognize communities that have implemented livable
9 community initiatives allowing individuals to age in place and to
10 remain in the home setting of their choice. Such initiatives shall
11 include, but not be limited to: (1) Affordable and accessible housing,
12 (2) community and social services, (3) planning and zoning
13 regulations, (4) walkability, and (5) transportation-related
14 infrastructure.

15 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2014*) The Department on Aging and
 16 the Department of Social Services shall hold quarterly meetings with
 17 nutrition service stakeholders to (1) develop recommendations to
 18 address complexities in the administrative processes of nutrition
 19 services, (2) establish quality control benchmarks, and (3) help move
 20 toward greater quality, efficiency and transparency in the elderly
 21 nutrition program. Stakeholders shall include, but not be limited to,
 22 area agencies on aging, access agencies, the Commission on Aging,
 23 nutrition providers, representatives of food security programs and
 24 contractors, nutrition host site representatives and consumers."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
