1 Strike lines 17 to 23, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(c) Any person, who in good faith believes that another person is
4 experiencing an opioid-related drug overdose may, if acting with
5 reasonable care, administer an opioid antagonist to such other person.
6 Any person, other than a licensed health care professional acting in the
7 ordinary course of such person's employment, who administers an
8 opioid antagonist in accordance with this subsection shall not be liable
9 for damages in a civil action or subject to criminal prosecution with
10 respect to the administration of such opioid antagonist."
