**"AN ACT PROVIDING NOTICE TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A MUNICIPALITY UPON THE RELEASE OF A REGISTERED SEXUAL OFFENDER INTO SUCH MUNICIPALITY."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 54-258 of the  
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

6 (2) (A) Any state agency, the Judicial Department, any state police  
7 troop or any local police department may, at its discretion, notify any  
8 government agency, private organization or individual of registration  
9 information when such agency, said department, such troop or such  
10 local police department, as the case may be, believes such notification  
11 is necessary to protect the public or any individual in any jurisdiction  
12 from any person who is subject to registration under section 54-251,  
13 54-252, 54-253 or 54-254.

14 (B) (1) Whenever a registrant is released into the community, or  
 15 whenever a registrant changes such registrant's address and notifies  
 16 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection of such  
 17 change pursuant to section 54-251, 54-252, 54-253 or 54-254, the  
 18 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, by  
 19 electronic mail, notify the superintendent of schools for the school  
 20 district in which the registrant resides, or plans to reside, of such  
 21 release or new address, and provide such superintendent with the  
 22 same registry information for such registrant that the department  
 23 makes available to the public through the Internet under subdivision  
 24 (1) of this subsection.

25 (2) Whenever a registrant is released into the community, or  
 26 whenever a registrant changes such registrant's address and notifies  
 27 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection of such  
 28 change pursuant to section 54-251, 54-252, 54-253 or 54-254, the  
 29 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, by  
 30 electronic mail, notify the chief executive officer of the municipality in  
 31 which the registrant resides, or plans to reside, of such release or new  
 32 address, and provide such chief executive officer with the same  
 33 registry information for such registrant that the department makes  
 34 available to the public through the Internet under subdivision (1) of  
 35 this subsection."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
