"AN ACT REQUIRING AN ONLINE EXPLANATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES OF ANY CONTRACT EXTENDED WITHOUT USING COMPETITIVE BIDDING."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Each candidate on a
4 ballot for any election, as defined in section 9-1 of the general statutes,
5 may provide to the registrars of voters of any town in which such
6 ballot shall be voted upon the name and contact information, including
7 instructions regarding leaving a message, for an individual who
8 should be notified in the event that the hours of a polling place may be
9 or have been extended, as provided in subsection (b) of this section.

10 (b) If the registrars of voters of a town are aware of any proceeding

11 in court or order of a court concerning the extension of the hours of
12 any polling place in such town beyond those hours provided in section
13 9-174 or 9-438 of the general statutes, the registrars shall immediately
14 notify any individual identified in subsection (a) of this section for
15 each candidate on any ballot to be voted upon at such polling place of
16 the proceeding or order. If a registrar fails to reach such individual on
17 a first attempt, the registrar shall leave a message for such individual
18 pursuant to instructions provided by such individual under subsection
19 (a) of this section. Any registrar who notifies an individual of a
20 proceeding shall not be required to notify such individual of the
21 outcome of such proceeding."
