Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEDUCTIBILITY OF SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS.

Statement of Purpose: To provide more senior citizens with the ability to deduct Social Security benefits from their Connecticut income tax. A Connecticut taxpayer currently can deduct one hundred per cent of the federally taxable Social Security benefits if the taxpayer has income less than fifty thousand dollars for a single filer, or sixty thousand dollars if the taxpayer files jointly.
