Title: AN ACT CONCERNING MORTGAGE SERVICERS, CONNECTICUT FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS, CONSUMER CREDIT LICENSES, THE FORECLOSURE MEDIATION PROGRAM, MINOR REVISIONS TO THE BANKING STATUTES, THE MODERNIZATION OF CORPORATION LAW AND REVERSE MORTGAGE TRANSACTIONS.

Statement of Purpose: To require notification when a loan production office will be permanently closed, clarify that business and industrial development corporation licenses are not transferable or assignable, increase certain fees and expand the definition of automated teller machines.
