Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE TIME LIMITATION FOR PROSECUTING A MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATION OR OFFENSE THAT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON.

Statement of Purpose: To toll the statute of limitation on the prosecution of a motor vehicle violation that caused the death or serious physical injury of another person if the offender evaded responsibility for the violation and the offender's identity is therefore unknown.
