Title: AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT FRAUD.

Statement of Purpose: To remove the ability of unemployment compensation claims examiners to waive the repayment of overpayments and to require the Labor Department to (1) register with the State Information Data Exchange System for the purpose of administering chapter 567 of the general statutes, (2) review the methods it uses to award unemployment benefits, and (3) implement a system to allow recipients of benefits to verify that they are receiving the proper amount of benefits.
