**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE ASSESSMENT OF PROPOSED PRIVATIZATION CONTRACTS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To add an additional requirement for privatization contracts involving reimbursable personal services, to permit the cost-benefit analysis to be waived under certain circumstances and to nullify any privatization contract other than for an emergency procurement entered into or renewed without complying with the provisions of section 4e-16 of the general statutes.
