**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING COURT OPERATIONS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To authorize chief probation officers and supervisory judicial marshals to administer oaths in the performance of their duties, to remove the political party restriction on who may serve on the State Marshal Commission, to remove the restriction on who the Chief Justice may designate to serve on the State Library Board, to remove a retired judge from the membership of the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners, to clarify whether the court has to schedule a restraining order application for a hearing, regardless of whether the affidavit meets the statutory criteria, to allow the Chief Court Administrator to place venue of housing matters in the judicial district, to clarify that contact by a respondent upon a protected person in certain instances does not constitute a violation of a restraining order, to allow an authorized official of the Judicial Branch to purchase body armor on behalf of a judicial marshal, to make minor and technical changes to bail bonds, to repeal a statute authorizing a special education pilot program, and to repeal the Wrongful Conviction Commission.
