

Many States have Sunday Hunting and have no safety issues even a small state like Rhode Island. Much of the State Land has been purchase through taxes paid by Sportsmen, yet we cannot access it on Sundays, others have contributed zero and have Sunday access. This is unacceptable to me and should be corrected.

Sunday hunting on Private Land should be strictly up to the landowner's discretion and will have zero impact on anyone using State Land.
