The Committee on Commerce reported through SEN. LEBEAU of the 3rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE HADDAM HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2014*) The sum of fifty thousand dollars is
2 appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community
3 Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June
4 30, 2015, for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the Haddam
5 Historical Society for the operating expenses of the Connecticut Spring
6 Antiques Show.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Explanation

The bill appropriates \$50,000 in FY 15 to a grant-in-aid for Haddam Historical Society for the operating expenses related to the Connecticut Spring Antiques Show. sHB 5030, the revised FY 15 budget bill, as favorably reported by the Appropriations Committee, does not include this appropriation.

The bill also results in the budget being closer to the spending cap in FY 15. Total appropriations contained in sHB 5030, the FY 15 revised budget bill, as favorably reported by the Appropriations Committee, result in the FY 15 budget being under the spending cap by approximately \$700,000. The appropriations contained in the bill would result in the FY 15 budget being under the spending cap by approximately \$650,000.

The Out Years

The bill appropriates funding in FY 15 only.
