**"AN ACT CONCERNING CONNECTICUT'S RECYCLING AND MATERIALS MANAGEMENT STRATEGY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 22a-219d of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

5 (a) There is established a fund to be known as the "Municipal  
6 Tipping Fee Fund". The purpose of the Municipal Tipping Fee Fund  
7 shall be to provide for the payment of grants to municipalities  
8 pursuant to section 22a-219b or 22a-219c. The fund shall contain any  
9 moneys required by law to be deposited in the fund and shall be held  
10 in trust separate and apart from all other moneys, funds and accounts.  
11 Investment earnings credited to the assets of said fund shall become  
12 part of the assets of said fund. Any balance remaining in said fund at  
13 the end of any fiscal year shall be carried forward in said fund for the  
14 fiscal year next succeeding.

15     (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section,  
16     the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection may make  
17     a grant-in-aid to the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority from  
18     the Municipal Tipping Fee Fund for the purpose of funding the  
19     operations of the authority's Garbage Museum."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
