**"AN ACT DECREASING THE TIME FRAMES FOR URGENT CARE  
ADVERSE DETERMINATION REVIEW REQUESTS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 38a-478l of the  
4 2014 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following  
5 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

6 (b) (1) The consumer report card shall be known as the "Consumer  
7 Report Card on Health Insurance Carriers in Connecticut" and shall  
8 include (A) all health care centers licensed pursuant to chapter 698a,  
9 (B) the fifteen largest licensed health insurers that use provider  
10 networks and that are not included in subparagraph (A) of this  
11 subdivision, (C) the state medical loss ratio of each such health care  
12 center or licensed health insurer, (D) the federal medical loss ratio of  
13 each such health care center or licensed health insurer, (E) the  
14 information required under subdivision (6) of subsection (a) of section  
15 38a-478c, [and] (F) information concerning mental health services, as

16 specified in subsection (c) of this section, and (G) the percentage of  
17 urgent care requests, as defined in section 38a-591a, in which a  
18 decision was rendered by each such health center or licensed health  
19 insurer within twenty-four hours, forty-eight hours and seventy-two  
20 hours. The insurers selected pursuant to subparagraph (B) of this  
21 subdivision shall be selected on the basis of Connecticut direct written  
22 health premiums from such network plans."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
