"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES OF THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND THE PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES COMMISSION."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 51-50 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (b) (1) Each judge, family support magistrate or compensation
7 commissioner who first commences service as a judge, family support
8 magistrate or compensation commissioner on or after January 1, 1981,
9 and who attains the age of seventy while serving in his or her
10 respective office or who is retired because of disability shall receive as
11 retirement, annually, two-thirds of the salary the judge, family support
12 magistrate or compensation commissioner was receiving at the time of
13 his or her retirement.

14 (2) Each judge, family support magistrate or compensation
 15 commissioner who first commences service as a judge, family support
 16 magistrate or compensation commissioner on or after July 1, 2014, and
 17 who attains the age of seventy while serving in his or her respective
 18 office or who is retired because of disability shall receive as retirement,
 19 annually: (A) If a judge, family support magistrate or compensation
 20 commissioner has served eight years or more at the time of his or her
 21 retirement under this section, two-thirds of the salary the judge, family
 22 support magistrate or compensation commissioner was receiving at
 23 the time of his or her retirement, (B) if a judge, family support
 24 magistrate or compensation commissioner has served fewer than eight
 25 years, but at least four years at the time of his or her retirement under
 26 this section, fifty per cent of the salary the judge, family support
 27 magistrate or compensation commissioner was receiving at the time of
 28 his or her retirement, or (C) if a judge, family support magistrate or
 29 compensation commissioner has served less than four years at the time
 30 of his or her retirement under this section, one-third of the salary the
 31 judge, family support magistrate or compensation commissioner was
 32 receiving at the time of his or her retirement."
