**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN OFF-SITE FARM WINERY SALES
AND TASTING PERMIT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 30-48 of the 2014 supplement to
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

6 (a) No backer or permittee of one permit class shall be a backer or
7 permittee of any other permit class except in the case of any class of
8 airport, railroad, airline and boat permits, and except that: (1) A backer
9 of a hotel or restaurant permit may be a backer of both such classes; (2)
10 a holder or backer of a manufacturer permit for a brew pub, a
11 restaurant permit or a cafe permit may be a holder or backer of any
12 other or all of such classes; (3) a holder or backer of a restaurant permit
13 may be a holder or backer of a bowling establishment permit; (4) a
14 backer of a restaurant permit may be a backer of a coliseum permit or a
15 coliseum concession permit, or both, when such restaurant is within a

16 coliseum; (5) a backer of a hotel permit may be a backer of a coliseum
17 permit or a coliseum concession permit, or both; (6) a backer of a
18 coliseum permit may be a backer of a coliseum concession permit; (7) a
19 backer of a coliseum concession permit may be a backer of a coliseum
20 permit; (8) a backer of a grocery store beer permit may be a backer of a
21 package store permit if such was the case on or before May 1, 1996; (9)
22 a backer of a university permit may be a backer of a nonprofit theater
23 permit; (10) subject to the discretion of the department, a backer of a
24 permit provided for in section 30-33b, may be a backer of any other
25 retail on-premise consumption permit, including those permits
26 provided for in section 30-33b; (11) a backer of a nonprofit theater
27 permit may be a holder or backer of a hotel permit; (12) a holder or
28 backer of a restaurant permit may be a holder or backer of a special
29 outing facility permit; (13) a backer of a concession permit may be a
30 backer of a coliseum permit or a coliseum concession permit, or both;
31 (14) a holder of an out-of-state winery shipper's permit for wine may
32 be a holder of an in-state transporter's permit or an out-of-state entity
33 wine festival permit issued pursuant to section 30-37m, or of both such
34 permits; (15) a holder of an out-of-state shipper's permit for alcoholic
35 liquor other than beer may be a holder of an in-state transporter's
36 permit; and (16) a holder of a manufacturer's permit for a farm winery
37 may be a holder of an in-state transporter's permit, a wine festival
38 permit issued pursuant to section 30-37l, a farmers' market wine sales
39 permit issued pursuant to subsection (a) of section 30-37o, an off-site
40 farm winery sales and tasting permit issued pursuant to section 1 of
41 this act or of any combination of such permits. Any person may be a
42 permittee of more than one permit. A person may be a permittee under
43 a permit provided for in section 30-33b and a backer of any other retail
44 on-premise consumption permit, including those permits provided for
45 in section 30-33b. The operator of a racing or jai alai exhibition with
46 pari-mutuel betting licensed by the Department of Consumer
47 Protection may be a backer of any permit provided for in section 30-
48 33b. No holder of a manufacturer permit for a brew pub and no spouse
49 or child of such holder may be a holder or backer of more than three
50 restaurant permits or cafe permits."
