**"AN ACT MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO STATE EXPENDITURES  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 51-50 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5 *passage*):

6 (b) (1) Each judge, family support magistrate or compensation  
7 commissioner who first commences service as a judge, family support  
8 magistrate or compensation commissioner on or after January 1, 1981,  
9 and prior to July 1, 2014, and who attains the age of seventy while  
10 serving in his or her respective office or who is retired because of  
11 disability shall receive as retirement, annually, two-thirds of the salary  
12 the judge, family support magistrate or compensation commissioner  
13 was receiving at the time of his or her retirement.

14     (2) Each judge, family support magistrate or compensation  
 15     commissioner who first commences service as a judge, family support  
 16     magistrate or compensation commissioner on or after July 1, 2014, and  
 17     who attains the age of seventy while serving in his or her respective  
 18     office or who is retired because of disability shall receive as retirement,  
 19     annually, two-thirds of the salary the judge, family support magistrate  
 20     or compensation commissioner was receiving at the time of his or her  
 21     retirement, except that if a judge, family support magistrate or  
 22     compensation commissioner has served fewer than ten years at the  
 23     time of his or her retirement under this subdivision, his or her  
 24     retirement salary shall be a reduced amount determined as follows:  
 25     (A) Two-thirds of the salary the judge, family support magistrate or  
 26     compensation commissioner was receiving at the time of his or her  
 27     retirement, multiplied by (B) a fraction, the numerator of which is the  
 28     number of years of his or her completed service and the denominator  
 29     of which is ten."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
