"AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO BIRTH CERTIFICATES AND PARENTAL HEALTH INFORMATION FOR ADOPTED PERSONS."

1 Change the effective date of sections 1 to 11, inclusive, to "Effective
2 January 1, 2015"

3 Strike section 3 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

4 "Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2015*) (a) Not later than January 1,
5 2015, the Department of Public Health shall develop a health history
6 form to be used for a birth parent to record his or her health history.
7 The department shall provide each birth parent considering placement
8 of a child for adoption with such health history form. The completed
9 form shall be returned to the department.

10 (b) When the department receives the completed health history
11 form from a birth parent, the department shall maintain such form in a
12 confidential file and shall provide copies only to the adopted person
13 who is eighteen years of age or older or such adopted person's adult
14 child or grandchild, upon request. A completed health history form

15 shall not be considered a public record for the purposes of section 1-
16 210 of the general statutes."
