"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 10-66q of the 2014 supplement to the general
4 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
5 (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

6 (a) Not later than April 1, 2014, each regional educational service
7 center shall develop a uniform regional school calendar to be used by
8 each local or regional board of education in the area served by such
9 regional educational service center, in accordance with the provisions
10 of [subsections (b) and (c)] subsection (b) of this section. Such uniform
11 regional school calendars shall be consistent with the guidelines for a
12 uniform regional school calendar developed pursuant to section 321 of
13 public act 13-247. Not later than April 1, 2014, each regional
14 educational service center shall submit such uniform regional school

15 calendar to the State Board of Education for approval. Not later than
16 five days after such approval, such regional educational service center
17 shall submit such approved uniform regional school calendar to the
18 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
19 of matters relating to education, in accordance with the provisions of
20 section 11-4a.

21 (b) For the school year commencing July 1, 2014, and each school
22 year thereafter, a local or regional board of education may adopt the
23 uniform regional school calendar developed and approved pursuant to
24 subsection (a) of this section.

25 [(c) For the school year commencing July 1, 2015, and each school
26 year thereafter, each local and regional board of education shall use the
27 uniform regional school calendar developed and approved pursuant to
28 subsection (a) of this section.]

29 [(d)] (c) (1) Not later than July 1, 2014, the Commissioner of
30 Education shall submit a report on the implementation of uniform
31 regional school calendars and any recommendations for legislation
32 relating to such implementation to the joint standing committee of the
33 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education,
34 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a.

35 (2) Not later than January 1, 2015, and [July 1, 2016] annually
36 thereafter, the Commissioner of Education shall submit a report on the
37 implementation of uniform regional school calendars in those school
38 districts that have adopted a uniform regional school calendar,
39 pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, and any recommendations
40 for legislation relating to such implementation to the joint standing
41 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
42 relating to education, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
43 4a.

44 [(3) Not later than January 1, 2016, and July 1, 2017, and annually
45 thereafter, the Commissioner of Education shall submit a report on the

46 implementation of uniform regional school calendars, pursuant to
47 subsection (c) of this section, and any recommendations for legislation
48 relating to such implementation to the joint standing committee of the
49 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education,
50 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a.]"

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
