**"AN ACT CONCERNING MUTUAL CONSOLIDATION OF DISPATCH FACILITIES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 10-244a of the 2014 supplement to the general  
4 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof  
5 (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

6 (a) For the school year commencing July 1, 2013, and each school  
7 year thereafter, no municipality or local or regional board of education  
8 may employ or enter into an agreement, as described in subdivision (2)  
9 of subsection (b) of section 53a-217b, with any person, other than a  
10 sworn member of an organized local police department or a retired  
11 police officer as provided in subsection (b) of this section, to provide  
12 security services in a public school if such person will possess a  
13 firearm, as defined in section 53a-3, while in the performance of his or  
14 her duties.

15 (b) A municipality or a local or regional board of education may  
 16 employ or enter into an agreement with a retired police officer to  
 17 provide security services in a public school if such retired police officer  
 18 is a qualified retired law enforcement officer, as defined in 18 USC  
 19 926C, as amended from time to time. Such retired police officer shall  
 20 receive annual training pursuant to section 7-294x and shall  
 21 successfully complete annual firearms training provided by a certified  
 22 firearms instructor that meets or exceeds the standards of the Police  
 23 Officer Standards and Training Council or 18 USC 926C, as amended  
 24 from time to time. Such retired police officer shall not be subject to the  
 25 licensing requirements of part II of chapter 534.

26 (c) For the purposes of subsection (b) of this section, "retired police  
 27 officer" means (1) a sworn member of an organized local police  
 28 department who was certified by the Police Officer Standards and  
 29 Training Council and retired or separated in good standing from such  
 30 department or a sworn member of the Division of State Police within  
 31 the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection who  
 32 retired or separated in good standing from said division, (2) a sworn  
 33 federal law enforcement agent who retired or separated in good  
 34 standing from such federal law enforcement service, or (3) a sworn  
 35 officer of an organized police department in another state who was  
 36 certified under standards that meet or exceed the standards of the  
 37 Police Officer Standards and Training Council for certification in this  
 38 state and who retired or separated in good standing from such  
 39 department."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
