**"AN ACT CONCERNING DELIVERY OF THE YELLOW PAGES  
PHONE BOOK."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2014, the  
4 Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, in consultation with the office of  
5 the Attorney General and the Office of Consumer Counsel, shall  
6 submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of  
7 the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General  
8 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy. Such report  
9 shall include an analysis of whether any mission or any work of social  
10 welfare organizations, as defined in Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal  
11 Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal  
12 revenue code of the United States, as amended from time to time, for  
13 telecommunications and utility-related matters is in the best interest of  
14 ratepayers. If the authority determines, in such report, that any  
15 mission or any work of social welfare organizations is not in the best

16 interest of ratepayers, including, but not limited to, any third-party  
17 endorsements, the authority shall implement the relevant provisions of  
18 the report."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
