"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2014*) The Department of
4 Education shall conduct a study of the costs associated with
5 implementation of the Common Core State Standards, adopted by the
6 State Board of Education on July 7, 2010, pursuant to section 10-4 of the
7 general statutes, and the Smarter Balanced assessments. The
8 department, in conducting such study, shall (1) investigate how the
9 state-wide implementation of such standards will affect (A) student
10 learning and student academic achievement, (B) the administration of
11 the mastery examination, pursuant to section 10-14n of the general
12 statutes, and student performance on such examination, (C) state and
13 local costs, including the costs associated with the creation of
14 technology infrastructure necessary for implementing the Common

15 Core State Standards and the Smarter Balanced assessments, and (D)
 16 teacher performance evaluations and teacher improvement and
 17 remediation plans, (2) analyze, using the items described in
 18 subparagraphs (A) to (D), inclusive, of subdivision (1) of this section,
 19 the implementation of such standards in those school districts that
 20 have commenced implementation of the Common Core State
 21 Standards and Smarter Balanced assessments, and (3) analyze and
 22 compare the effect on student learning and student academic
 23 achievement in states that have begun implementation of the Common
 24 Core State Standards and Smarter Balanced assessments. Not later
 25 than January 1, 2015, the department shall submit such study and a
 26 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
 27 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
 28 relating to education, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
 29 4a of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Sec. 501	July 1, 2014	New section
