"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 10-76h of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2014*):

6 (b) Upon receipt of a written request for a special education hearing
7 made in accordance with subsection (a) of this section, the Department
8 of Education shall appoint an impartial hearing officer who shall
9 schedule a hearing which shall be [held] conducted in no more than
10 four days and the decision written and mailed not later than forty-five
11 days after the commencement of the hearing pursuant to the
12 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 USC 1400 et seq., as
13 amended from time to time. An extension of the forty-five-day time
14 limit may be granted by the hearing officer at the request of either

15 party to the hearing."
