**"AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 54-258 of the  
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
5 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

6 (2) (A) Any state agency, the Judicial Department, any state police  
7 troop or any local police department may, at its discretion, notify any  
8 government agency, private organization or individual of registration  
9 information when such agency, said department, such troop or such  
10 local police department, as the case may be, believes such notification  
11 is necessary to protect the public or any individual in any jurisdiction  
12 from any person who is subject to registration under section 54-251,  
13 54-252, 54-253 or 54-254.

14 (B) (1) Whenever a registrant is released into the community, the

15 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, by  
 16 electronic mail, notify the superintendent of schools for the school  
 17 district in which the registrant resides, or plans to reside, of such  
 18 release and provide such superintendent with the same registry  
 19 information for such registrant that the department makes available to  
 20 the public through the Internet under subdivision (1) of this  
 21 subsection.

22 (2) Whenever a registrant is released into the community, the  
 23 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, by  
 24 electronic mail, notify the chief executive officer of the municipality in  
 25 which the registrant resides, or plans to reside, of such release and  
 26 provide such chief executive officer with the same registry information  
 27 for such registrant that the department makes available to the public  
 28 through the Internet under subdivision (1) of this subsection."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
