In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes as amended, notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Health proposes regulations concerning "**Public Swimming Areas**" under the authority of 19a-36 of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

**Statement of Purpose:** The purpose of the regulation is (A) to make consistent with current practice and standards; (B) to protect public health and safety for persons using public swimming areas; and (C) to repeal the obsolete sections 19-13-B34 and 19-13-B36 and replace them with the new 19a-36-B61.

Persons wishing to present their views and arguments regarding these regulations are invited to do so in writing within thirty (30) days of electronic posting of this to the regulations website of the Secretary of the State. A public hearing will be scheduled if requested by fifteen (15) or more persons, a governmental subdivision or agency, or an association having not less than fifteen (15) members, provided that notice of such request is made within (30) thirty days of electronic posting of this notice to the regulations website of the Secretary of the State.
