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NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND REGULATION

In accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, pursuant to Section 227a of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend the regulations regarding "Ignition Interlock Devices", Section 14-227a-26a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Statement of purpose: The purpose of the amendment to the regulation is to enumerate the five permitted travel destinations for persons who have been convicted of a second violation of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol and who are permitted to operate a motor vehicle with an ignition interlock device ("IID"). During the first year of operation with an IID, the operator shall only travel to or from:

- work;
- school;
- an alcohol or drug abuse treatment program;
- an ignition interlock service center; or
- an appointment with a probation officer.

This change is the result of legislative action during the past two years. The first four travel restrictions listed were established by the legislature in 2012 and the fifth one was added during the 2013 session of the General Assembly.
