Department of Labor **“UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION OVERPAYMENTS”** The Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is amended Sections 31-273-2 through 31-273-6, inclusive; 31-273-6a; 31-273-7; 31-244-4a; 31-244-6a; 31-244-7a; and 31-244-9a. (CLJ Notice Date 11/6/2013; A.G. Approval Date 2/24/2014) - Bearing a Deadline Date of 5/8/2014
