I, Melody A. Currey, Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles, an agency of the State of Connecticut, hereby certify that:

(1) On February 28, 2014, the agency's intent to amend or adopt its regulation concerning "Assessment of Points Against an Operator's License for Motor Vehicle Law Violations", was posted on the Secretary of the State's website, and on April 14, 2014 the agency's notice of decision to take action on the proposed regulation was also posted on the Secretary of the State's website.

(2) On April 15, 2014, the agency gave notice by mail to each joint standing committee of the general assembly having cognizance of the subject matter of the proposed regulation.

(3) The agency gave notice by mail to those persons who have requested advance notice of the regulation-making proceeding of the agency.

(3) The agency provided a copy of the proposed regulation to those persons requesting it.

(5) The agency prepared a fiscal note, including an estimate of the cost or of the revenue impact on the state or any municipality of the state. A true copy of the fiscal note is attached.

(6) On January 24, 2014, the agency prepared a small business impact statement which indicated that no regulatory flexibility analysis was required and on April 17, 2014, notified the Department of Economic and Community Development on of its intent to adopt the proposed regulation(s).

(7) All interested persons were given until March 30, 2014 to submit data, views or arguments concerning the proposed regulations and to inspect and copy the fiscal note referenced.

(8) On N/A, a hearing was held by the agency concerning said proposal, at 60 State Street Wethersfield DMV, Wethersfield, CT.

(9) No written or oral submissions with respect to the proposed regulation(s) were received by the agency. As such, there have been no revisions to either the proposed regulation or the fiscal note.

(10) On N/A, the agency mailed to all persons who submitted data, views or arguments in writing, and to all persons who made statements or oral arguments at the hearing held (if any) and who requested notification, notice that the agency has decided to take action on the proposed regulation(s), and that it has made available for copying and inspection; (a) the final wording of the proposed regulation (s); (b) a statement of the principal reasons in support of its intended actin; and (c) a statement of the principal considerations in opposition to its intended action as urged in written or oral comments on the proposed regulation(s) and its reasons for rejecting such considerations.
