Notice of Intent to Amend the Boating Safety Regulations to Create a Slow-No-Wake Zone on Lake Waramaug, Warren

In accordance with section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) the Commissioner of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) hereby gives notice of his intent to add Section 15-121-B15p to the Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies to create a slow-no-wake zone in the cove of Lake Waramaug adjacent to Lake Waramaug State Park. This amendment is being proposed under the authority granted to the Commissioner in CGS Section 15-121(b)(11) and pursuant to a vote of the town legislative body and petition of ten or more persons requesting the subject action under CGS Section 15-136.

Description: Under this proposal, a Slow-No-Wake zone will be implemented on Lake Waramaug in the northern portion of the cove adjacent to Lake Waramaug State Park, for the purpose of minimizing user conflicts by controlling boat wakes from powerboats in an area frequented by bathers and occupants of manually-propelled vessels.

The proposal of this amendment follows the May 16, 2013 vote of the Town of Warren legislative body and petition of ten or more persons pursuant to CGS Section 15-136(b)(2). There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the municipality or to the State. There is no anticipated adverse impact to small business.

Written Comments: All interested persons are invited to submit comments regarding the proposed amendment to the DEEP-Marine Headquarters, Boating Division, P.O. Box 280, Old Lyme, CT 06371. All comments should be directed to the attention of Timothy Delgado and must be received between 8:00 AM on the November 1, 2013 and 4:00 PM on November 22, 2013. Only those written comments containing the name and address of the commenter will be considered.

Notice of Second Extension of Comment Period

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) hereby gives notice that the comment period identified in the Notice of Intent to add Section 15-121-B15p to the Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies to create a slow-no-wake zone in the cove of Lake Waramaug adjacent to Lake Waramaug State Park has been extended for 45 days upon request and to ensure those citizens who may wish to provide comment have time to do so. While DEEP's prior notifications met legal requirements, extension of the comment period to January 6, 2014 is expected to generate additional input from the using public and is therefore, approved.

The original comment period was identified as November 1, 2013 to 4:00 PM November 22, 2013 and then broadened to October 1, 2013 to November 22, 2013 under a first extension. The comment period will now be extended as follows:

Written comments will now be accepted from October 1, 2013 to 4:00 PM January 6, 2014.
