SUBJECT: Review of Agenda Item 2014-018A for the November 25, 2014 Meeting

OFA has reviewed the state and municipal fiscal impact of item 2014-018A for the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection for the above meeting.<sup>1</sup> The following table summarizes our review.

While the agency estimate of state impact is reasonable, there could be a minimal state revenue gain, anticipated to be less than \$500 annually, if violations result in a fine of \$75 each.
