SUBJECT MATTER OF REGULATION: Lake Waramaug Slow-No-Wake Zone

---

**The Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies are amended by adding section 15-121-B15p as follows:**

(NEW) **Lake Waramaug Special Regulation.** No person shall operate a motorboat on Lake Waramaug in the towns of Washington, Warren and Kent in excess of slow-no-wake from May 15 through September 15, inclusive, in the cove adjacent to Lake Waramaug State Park in the area beginning at the northernmost tip of the cove, bounded by the shorelines, and southerly from said northernmost tip for a distance of 1,300 feet.

**Statement of Purpose**

*Pursuant to CGS Section 4-170(b)(3), "Each proposed regulation shall have a statement of its purpose following the final section of the regulation." Enter the statement here.*

Under this proposal, the boating safety regulations will be amended to add a Slow-No-Wake zone on Lake Waramaug in the northern portion of the cove adjacent to Lake Waramaug State Park from mid-May to mid-September, for the purpose of minimizing user conflicts by controlling boat wakes from powerboats in an area frequented by bathers and occupants of manually-propelled vessels during the time of year when user conflict is most likely to occur. The term "Slow-No-Wake" is defined in Section 15-121-A1 of the Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposal of this amendment as written is compelled by the 16 May 2013 vote of the Town of Warren legislative body and petition of ten or more persons, as prescribed under Section 15-136(b)(2).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the municipality or to the State. There is no anticipated adverse impact to small business.

This proposal is offered under the authority granted to the Commissioner in Section 15-121(b)(11) of the General Statutes.
