NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND REGULATIONS

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168((b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut (CGS), as amended, the Office of Policy and Management hereby gives notice that it proposes to amend regulations concerning Additional Veterans Exemption: Eligibility and State Reimbursement Procedures, under the authority of Public Act 13-224.

Statement of Purpose: Connecticut General Statutes Section 12-81g allows 100% disabled veterans an additional property tax exemption based on statutory income levels. Qualified veterans receive an additional exemption equal to twice the amount of the exemption. Public Act 13-224 amended Connecticut General Statutes Section 12-81g to allow for a municipal option which will provide 100% disabled veteran's property an additional exemption of three times the base exemption if the veterans income is below statutory limits. The purpose of this amendment is to incorporate this added exemption into the regulations.

The amended regulation also makes technical and conforming changes.
