



## Notice of Decision to Take Action on Proposed Regulations

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In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168(d) of the *General Statutes of the State of Connecticut (CGS)*, as amended, the **Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP)** hereby gives notice that it has decided to proceed with proposed regulations concerning Sport **Fishing in the Inland District, Permits for Liberation of Triploid Grass Carp**. Notice of intent to adopt, amend, or repeal these regulations was posted to the regulations webpage of the Secretary of the State on April 15, 2014.

A public hearing was held on May 19, 2014 and the public comment period was held open until June 3, 2014. DEEP received comments on the proposed regulation and has provided responses to those comments. The final wording of the proposed regulations, a summary of public comments and the explanatory statement containing a statement of the principal reasons in support of this intended action, a statement of the principal considerations in opposition to this intended action, and a statement of the agency's reasons for accepting or rejecting such considerations are available as provided for below:
