We strongly oppose **House Bill # 6824 “the budget bill”**.

This proposed “budget bill” by Governor Malloy removes funding for the Regional Fire Training Schools. Initial and ongoing training is necessary to protect the health and safety of the firefighters, and those whom which they serve.
