AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CHILDREN'S STATE FLOWER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Michaela Petit's Four-
- 2 O'Clocks, *Mirabilis jalapa*, shall be the children's state flower.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
