The Committee on Housing reported through REP. BUTLER of the 72nd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT MAKING A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO A STATUTE CONCERNING SUPPORTIVE HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 8-345 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2015*):

4 (d) The commissioner may designate a portion of the rental
5 assistance available under the program for tenant-based and project-
6 based supportive housing units. To the extent practicable, rental
7 assistance for supportive housing shall adhere to the requirements of
8 the federal Housing Choice Voucher Program, 42 USC 1437f(o),
9 relative to calculating the tenant's share of the rent to be paid.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2015</i>	8-345(d)
