AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL BLIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) The Secretary of the
- 2 Office of Policy and Management may adopt regulations, in
- 3 accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes,
- 4 concerning the prevention and remediation of municipal blight.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
