**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE PRESCRIBING OF OPIATES TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-FIVE IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the
- 2 prescribing of opiates to any person under the age of twenty-five,
- 3 except when opiates are to be administered to such person solely
- 4 during inpatient treatment within a hospital.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prevent the prescribing of opiates to certain persons in certain situations.
