**AN ACT CONCERNING RESIDENTIAL SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC
INSTALLATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 541 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 State Building Code be revised to require a residential solar
- 3 photovoltaic system be installed (1) with a switch, circuit breaker or
- 4 other device on the outside of the residential building to disconnect the
- 5 direct current conductors of such system, and (2) in a manner that
- 6 maintains access to the roof by a firefighter.

Statement of Purpose:

To require accessible disconnection of residential solar panels and roof access for firefighters when installing residential solar panels.
