**AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR A PERMIT TO CARRY A PISTOL OR REVOLVER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-28 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any applicant for a state or temporary state permit to carry a pistol
- 3 or revolver be disqualified from receiving such permit if such
- 4 applicant has been convicted of a criminal offense in another state or
- 5 subdivision of the United States, the essential elements of which are
- 6 the same as a disqualifying criminal offense for such permit under said
- 7 section.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that any applicant for a state or temporary state permit to carry a pistol or revolver be disqualified from receiving such permit if such applicant has been convicted of a criminal offense in another state or subdivision of the United States, the essential elements of which are the same as a disqualifying criminal offense for such permit under section 29-28 of the general statutes.
