**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE SUBSIDY FOR PUBLIC BUILDINGS  
TO ACHIEVE LEED CERTIFICATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a state subsidy for
- 2 public buildings to achieve LEED certification by the LEED Green
- 3 Building Rating System as defined under subdivision (7) of subsection
- 4 (a) of section 12-217mm.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish a state subsidy to help finance and encourage the transition of public buildings to more energy-efficient models and designs.
