**AN ACT PERMITTING A PRIVATE HOMEOWNER TO BRING AN ACTION IN THE SUPERIOR COURT AGAINST THE STATE FOR FLOOD DAMAGES CAUSED BY THE STATE'S FAILURE TO PROPERLY MAINTAIN A STATE ROAD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That, notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, the
- 2 General Assembly may authorize a private homeowner residing on
- 3 state Route 122 in New Haven to sue the state for flood damages
- 4 caused to the residence of such homeowner, which damages were
- 5 caused by the state's failure to properly maintain a state road.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow a private homeowner to sue the state for flood damages incurred because of the state's failure to properly maintain a state road.
