**AN ACT REDUCING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ELDERLY
PROPERTY TAX RELIEF.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-170v of the general statutes be amended to reduce
- 2 the current age of eligibility for property tax relief from seventy years
- 3 of age to sixty-five years of age.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow towns to provide property tax relief to more of its senior
citizens.
