***AN ACT REDUCING THE AMOUNT OF CERTAIN GRANTS AWARDED
UNDER THE CITIZENS' ELECTION PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-705 of the general statutes be amended to reduce the
- 2 amount of grants awarded under the Citizens' Election Program for
- 3 general election campaigns (1) from twenty-seven thousand eight
- 4 hundred fifty dollars to fifteen thousand dollars for qualifying
- 5 candidates for the office of state representative, and (2) from ninety-
- 6 four thousand six hundred ninety dollars to thirty-five thousand
- 7 dollars for qualifying candidates for the office of state senator.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the amount of grants awarded for general election
campaigns to General Assembly candidates participating in the
Citizens' Election Program.
