**AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT
COMPENSATION AND FOR-PROFIT DELIVERY SERVICE COURIER
COMPANIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (5) of subsection (a) of section 31-222 of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to ensure that the provisions of chapter 567 of the
- 3 general statutes shall not apply to services performed by the operator
- 4 of a motor vehicle transporting property for compensation pursuant to
- 5 an agreement with a contracting party if (1) the motor vehicle has a
- 6 gross vehicle weight rating in excess of ten thousand pounds, or (2) the
- 7 service is provided to a for-profit delivery service courier company as
- 8 defined in the June 7, 1994, Declaratory Ruling issued by the Labor
- 9 Department and certain other statutory requirements are satisfied.

Statement of Purpose:

To standardize the regulation of messenger carrier services.
