**AN ACT CONCERNING OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH
TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION WORKERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to remove the requirement
- 2 that construction workers working on state-funded projects renew
- 3 their Occupational Safety and Health Standards training every five
- 4 years.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the burdens faced by career construction workers in the state.
