AN ACT AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF HAZARDOUS WASTE STORED AT CERTAIN COMMERCIAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2015*) (a) For purposes of this
2 section, "generator", "hazardous waste" and "on-site" shall each have
3 the same meaning as provided for in 40 CFR 260.10 and "generates",
4 "permit" and "interim status" shall each have the same meaning as
5 used in 40 CFR 262.34.

6 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (O) of
7 subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 22a-449c-102 of the
8 regulations of Connecticut state agencies, a generator who generates
9 greater than one hundred kilograms but less than one thousand
10 kilograms of hazardous waste in a calendar month may accumulate
11 hazardous waste on-site for one hundred eighty days or less without a
12 permit or without having interim status provided the quantity of
13 waste accumulated on-site never exceeds six thousand kilograms.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2015	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To allow certain generators of hazardous waste to store six thousand kilograms of hazardous waste on-site during a six-month period, in accordance with federal regulations, rather than the current one-thousand-kilogram limit established under state regulations.
