**AN ACT PROHIBITING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION
FROM CHARGING A CONVENIENCE FEE FOR THE USE OF CREDIT
CARDS IN MAKING A TUITION PAYMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit institutions of
- 2 higher education from charging a convenience fee for the use of a
- 3 credit card in making a tuition payment.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the convenience fee colleges and universities charge when
credit cards are used as a means of paying tuition.
