AN ACT EXPANDING HEALTHY FOOD CHOICES ON STATE PROPERTY AND IN STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to require all food
2 and beverages purchased, sold, served or otherwise provided by any
3 state agency, as defined in section 1-79 of the general statutes,
4 including, but not limited to, through vending machines, on-site
5 vendors, cafeterias, meetings, events or institutional feeding programs
6 to meet minimum nutrition and procurement standards established by
7 the Department of Public Health, provided such standards are
8 consistent with health and sustainability guidelines set forth by the
9 federal General Services Administration for federal concessions and
10 vending operations.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand healthy food choices on state property and in state-supported institutions.
